

## Show Rules and Regulations

1. Make sure that all tack is cleaned prior to going to the show.
2. Make sure that your horse has been groomed and bathed prior to the show (Mane pulled; nose, ears and feet clipped). If you can not do this yourself, Triton will do it for you, for a fee.
3. Make sure that you have a leather top halter and lead line on the stall for shipping
4. Upon arrival at the show, YOU are responsible for your horse's stall. Stalls should be kept clean and mucked. Empty the muck basket after **each** use. If your horse requires additional shavings, they should be ordered at the show office.
5. Empty and wash your horse's water bucket daily and keep fresh water in it at ALL times.
6. Be **in the ring** to hack your horse at least 45 minutes prior to the start of the show each day. Your horse should be properly groomed and should not have shavings in their tail. So allow time for grooming and arrive early.
7. All horses and ponies will be ridden in a warm-up by a Triton professional on each day of a horse show. This will insure that both the rider and the horse have a safe and enjoyable experience while showing.
8. During the warm-ups, when the trainers ride your horse, please wait to be called. Bring your **groomed** horse to the ring with the bridle on, along with your number, martingale and saddle pad. It is important that **you** are present to watch your horse be ridden.
9. No parents at the in gate unless it is an emergency. It is important that the trainers concentrate on the riders and their horses during each course to insure that the rider has a successful and safe ride.
10. Keep the stall area clean and be sure to put your tack and personal items away.
